

## **Baby Blanket-Making Drive!**Simple Shell Stitch Baby Blanket



## **Materials**

Yarn: Worsted weight (approximately 800 yards)

Hook: 5.5 mm (US I-9)

Finished Size: Approximately 30" x 36"

## **Instructions**

- 1. Chain 100.
- 2. Row 1: In the 4th chain from the hook, work 2 double crochets (dc). Skip 2 chains, then work 3 dc in the next chain. Repeat across. Turn.
- 3. Row 2: Chain 3 (counts as first dc), work 2 dc in the space between the first and second dc of the previous row. \*Skip 2 stitches, work 3 dc in the space between the next 3-dc group.\* Repeat from \* to \* across. End with 1 dc in the turning chain. Turn.
- 4. Repeat Row 2 until the blanket reaches the desired length.
- 5. Finish off and weave in ends.
